> any location in the tower".The FAA's own Table of Offences and
> Penalties # 47 clearly does not differentiate between "sleeping or
> exhibiting a sleep like state".If anyone is familiar with these
> regulations it would certainly be the FAA's AAE division.And if anyone
> was to be questioned and who could state if the controllers in the
> videos were sleeping or attempting to sleep and exhibiting a sleep
> like state or were on position when these safety violations took place
> it would be the person who took the videos,myself.

> I like the other controllers were never asked anything
> regarding the sleeping controllers by AAE.In fact just the opposite
> happened when AAE's first statement to controllers being interviewed
> was"You are not in any trouble,we are not here to investigate sleeping
> and will not ask any questions in regards to that.

> This brings
> up a second point.The AAE investigators never report on controllers
> being in a sleep like state.This is a violation of regulation #46 Lack
> of Candor.Failure to give complete and truthful information in
> connection with any inquiry,investigation etc. related to the safety
> of the Nas or the flying public. Sean
