Pg 8. Note 1 states that once all SIPRNET cables are retracted the glass doors are no longer a security issue.

Comment: The glass doors are still a security issue because people can see through them and they are penetrable. A person can break the glass or pop the glass out of the frames. Glass doors are not solid core doors. There are safes inside the rooms with glass doors, which hold classified information. Each time the Agency pulls out a document for review, it is a violation of the Solid Core Doors policy.
