

According to transcribed minutes kept in the director's office, in September, 2015 the clinical executive board voted to reprivilege the ophthalmologist Dan Kim after he allowed his clinical privileges to lapse in November, 2014. This was done under the advice and urging of Kay Enchelmayer who demanded a second physician standards board for his presentation as a renewal instead of as a new hire due to lapse of privileges (of his own doing). This effectively blocked review of his cumulative professional record. She retired soon thereafter. Dr. Kim has not participated in clinical care during this most recent probationary period since April, 2014 and remains salaried/accrues leave and benefits and is to be sent outside of the facility for a focused performance evaluation and then likely reinstated. To date, the neurosurgeon's status has remained unchanged as well.
