In accordance with section 8306 of Public Law 110-28, on behalf of the U.S. Office of Special Counsel, I am submitting the Buy American Act report for fiscal year 2010.

OSC purchases most of its goods and services through the General Services Administration's Federal Supply Schedules, in accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Part 8 "Required Sources of Supplies and Services." Because vendors make their Buy American Act certifications directly to GSA under their federal supply schedule contracts, only GSA has the information about country of origin for those products. For the minority of items purchased outside of GSA procurement vehicles, the vendors submitted no exceptions to the use of domestic end products.

- OSC purchased articles, materials and supplies totaling \$391,833 in FY 2010, 100 percent of which were manufactured in the United States.
- There were no waivers granted with respect to such articles, materials, or supplies under the Buy American Act (41 USC 10a) for FY 2010


